Sambhajinagar and Lokseva Education Society's Arts & Science College, Garkheda Parisar, Ch. Sambhajinagar (Aurangabad) shall work out the modalities for dissemination of research data of Joint Research Project to any third party keeping in mind the mutual interest. However, both parties shall fulfill their obligation of disseminating the data to national data banks, as required by the- concerned funding agencies.

#### **6. Co-ordination Committee:-**

A Joint Coordination Committee for smooth and effective execution of activities and programs under this MoU may be formed by mutual consent.

#### **7. Period and Revision of MoU:-**

This Memorandum of understanding comes in to effect from the date of its signing and will remain in force initially for Five(05) Years. Its validity may be extended by mutual agreement between the two institutes.

### 8. Non-Exclusive Nature of this MoU:-

The MoU between Tirupati Shikshan Prasarak Va Sevabhavi Sanstha Sanchalit Vidyadhan College, , Plot No. 330, N-3, Cidco, Ch. Sambhajinagar and Lokseva Education Society's Arts & Science College, Garkheda Parisar, Ch. Sambhajinagar (Aurangabad) shall not come in the way of either partner from collaboration with the third party.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION  
BETWEEN**

**NATH SCHOOL OF BUSINESS & TECHNOLOGY  
GATE NO 5, MGM CAMPUS, N-6 CIDCO, Aurangabad**

**AND**

**VIDYADHAN COLLEGE  
Plot No. 330, N-3, CIDCO, Aurangabad**

Nath School of Business & Technology (NSBT) and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE recognize their strengths in research and education in one or more disciplines of management, technology and entrepreneurship and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest and in accordance with the terms and conditions outlined in this memorandum of understanding (MoU).

**A. Objectives**

The goal is to foster collaboration, create an enabling educational ecosystem, provide opportunities for innovation and leadership, and to facilitate the advancement of knowledge based on reciprocity, best effort, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree:

- a) to exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) to exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
- c) to jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
- d) to jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein





e) to jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein

f) to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at the Undergraduate and Graduate levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE further agree that detailed terms and conditions guiding each activity identified above will be determined and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, person(s) responsible for its implementation, etc.

### **B. Joint Sponsored Research, Development and Consulting**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE.

### **C. Exchange of Faculty, Guest Faculty and Staff**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to encourage collaboration between faculty members from the two institutions. Specifically, institutions will encourage their faculty members to undertake short visits to or take up fixed-term visiting assignments at each other's institution as per the existing norms. Terms and conditions for each visit or assignment, including those concerning stipend, travel, and housing, name of the concerned faculty member, will be worked out between NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE.

### **D. Student Exchange**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree that student exchange will be guided by the principles listed below. A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.

b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as a full-time student at his/her home institution.

c) An exchange student will be considered a full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.





- d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.
- e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.
- f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established a corresponding number of credits between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.
- g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.
- h) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.
- i) The exchange students will pay tuition and other fees at their home institution.

#### **E. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE will exchange information on research and educational programmes and teaching/learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes. Further, NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material, and other relevant literature, while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

#### **F. Joint Conferences, workshops, and short-term courses**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in conferences, workshops, and short-term courses. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE.

#### **G. Intellectual Property**

NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE agree to respect each other's rights to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

#### **H. Co-ordination**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of (a) Executive Director, NSBT, or his/her nominee, (b) Principal, VIDYADHAN COLLEGE or his/her nominee, (c) Programme Director from the side of NSBT, and (d) Programme Coordinator/HoD from the side of VIDYADHAN COLLEGE will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.


### I. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date representatives of the two institutions sign it. It will remain valid for two years and may be continued thereafter subject to suitable review and agreement. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution three months in advance. Once terminated, neither NSBT nor VIDYADHAN COLLEGE will be responsible for any financial or otherwise losses that the other institutions may suffer. However, NSBT and VIDYADHAN COLLEGE will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.


### J. Arbitration Clause
